- Send all embedded charts, graphs and/or images separately as high resolution image files.
- References may be included at the end; however may not be published due to space constraints.
- Please include high-resolution .jpg headshots of all authors with your submission.
- New Accountant does not peer review articles unless you provide a written request for peer review with your submission.
- Published peer reviewed articles are labeled in the magazine as peer reviewed.
